

CAISSON DRILL OPERATOR

Job Summary

Safely and efficiently operates caisson drill rigs, to meet project needs and accomplish project goals. Drill Rig operators may be asked to operate other heavy construction equipment as needed. This position will travel to projects within Colorado and may be asked to work at projects out of state.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Receives written or oral instructions from supervisor regarding project drilling.
- Moves and operates drill rig to meet the goals of construction activity.
- Observes markings on ground, hand signals, or grade stakes to remove and place material, when operating machine.
- Inspects, cleans, maintains, and lubricates equipment.
- Read project plans and operate equipment accordingly.

Qualifications

- Ability Drill 18"-72" diameter shafts for Caisson Installation, using hydraulic drill rigs.
- Experience in Wet and Dry Drilling Methods. (Segmental casing)
- Experience in Bentonite mixing, installation, and removal.
- Experience in Temp Casing installation and removal.
- Commercial and CDOT experience preferred.
- Experience in a heavy highway/heavy civil construction environment.
- Experience building bridges preferred.
- CDL License is a Plus.
- Foreman Experience is a Plus.
- Ability to Operate other Equipment is a Plus.
- Crane Operator Certification is a Plus.
- Soil Nail Drilling Experience is a Plus.
- Travel may be required.

Work Environment
