Job Summary

Installs, removes, rebuilds, repairs, and services power driven machines and equipment, including but not limited to, backhoes, cranes, excavators, front end loaders, loader backhoes, forklifts, compactors, motor graders, bulldozers, and uni-loaders by performing the following duties.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Receives written or oral instructions from supervisor regarding equipment to be serviced.
- Rebuilds and repairs systems, motors, and engines.
- Welds as needed.
- Inspects, cleans, maintains, and lubricates equipment.
- Participate and complete training in operation of new equipment.
- Possess essential mechanic tools required to perform job functions.
