

HEAVY HAUL TRUCK DRIVER

Duties and Responsibilities

- Transport heavy construction equipment through the Denver metro area utilizing a lowboy trailer and 2-3-2 combination trailer.
- Operate various types and sizes of trucks and trailers, on and off the highway, according to local, state, federal and company regulations.
- Knowledge and ability to maintain and perform all paperwork in accordance with Federal, State and/or Company requirements.
- Knowledge of safety rules for heavy highway construction sites and Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulations and ability to maintain 100% compliance.
- Job requires manual labor including climbing, lifting, and operating tie-down chain binders.
- Job works 55-60 hours per week.

Qualifications

- High School Diploma or GED is preferred
- At least two (2) years of Lowboy transport experience
- CDL Class A, Hazmat, Tanker, and Double/Triple endorsement is required
- Must pass DOT Physical and Drug Screen
- Applications with Serious Driving Violations will not be considered
- Applicants must provide experience references and pass a pre-employment DOT/background investigation and drug screening.

Reasoning Ability:

Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form. Ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variables in standardized situations.

Work Environment:

walk; use hands, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; climb or balance; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl and talk or hear.
